TEXT: Help your doctor to help you.

The twelve leading causes of death in advanced countries are now heart disease, cancer, stroke, accidents, flu, pneumonia and bronchitis, diabetes, birth injuries, cirrhosis of the liver, congenital malformation and suicide.

Our vices catch up with us: cigarettes, alcohol, physical inactivity and overeating are the major contributors to the causes of these killing diseases. Medicine has little help to offer for those self-induced conditions of ill health. Surgery is the only treatment which offers a chance of long time survival for people with lung cancer.
